Slades Park 3G Football Pitch Code of Conduct

- Respect People in the park and school – Too much noise, any bad language or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Respect Each Other – Players, officials and spectators need your respect.
- Respect the Facility – It is a FIFA standard pitch and provides a high-quality facility to the community.
- Respect the next user – Always leave the facility litter free, goals put away and as you would wish to find it.

RESPECT YOURSELVES, RESPECT THE GAME

This code of conduct applies to anyone involved in individuals or groups using the Slades Park 3G Pitches, whether responsible for the booking or attending as a spectator or participating in a booked session.

The 3G Football pitch at Slades Park is fully FA and FIFA compliant. The surface can only be maintained if ALL users comply with the rules.

Please note:

- No smoking or vaping on or near the facility
- No drinks other than water on the pitch
- The correct footwear must be worn by EVERYONE
- All rubbish must be removed and correctly disposed of at the end of every session
- All use must end by 22:00 every day

Access

The Slades Park 3G Pitches are accessed using the community entrance only. This entrance is signposted and situated off the path running between the Bournemouth Learning Centre and the Community Centre. 3G Pitch users should use the Slades car park.

Glenmoor and Winton Academy should not be used as an access point to the facility. There is no access to the pitch from the Academy site.

Car Parking

The Slades car park provides free car parking for 3 hours, Monday-Friday 8am-6pm and is free after 6pm and at weekends. Please note, it is still necessary to get a parking ticket from the machines.

Toilets and Changing Facilities

The changing and toilet facilities available to 3G Pitch users are in 'Block B', situated in the Slades Car Park (three minutes' walk from the 3G Pitch within the park area). This building must be kept locked when not in use. A key for this building will be provided.

Floodlights

Slades Park 3G has LED floodlighting, when in use it is the responsibility of the hirer to ensure they are switched off at the end of the session unless there is another user immediately following their session. Active Dorset will inform the hirer if this is the case.

Bookings

All bookings MUST be made via Active Dorset - sladespark@activedorset.org

Block bookings and trusted club users will be given access to facility keys as appropriate. For one-off bookings or infrequent users' access will be made available by previous arrangement with Active Dorset.

Cancellation and amendments of lets

The lead booker must give at least 5 working days' notice to cancel or amend the booking. If the booking holder fails to give enough notice it will be charged at the relevant letting rate.

Should Active Dorset be required to cancel a booking where possible they will endeavour to give 10 days' notice however in urgent circumstances i.e. severe weather less notice may be given.

Active Dorset reserve the right to refuse bookings where:

- Teams/individuals requesting a booking have previously acted out of accordance with the facility rules and/or code of conduct.
- It is considered that the teams/individuals requesting a booking are unlikely to act in accordance with the facility rules and/or code of conduct.
- Teams/individuals requesting a booking have outstanding obligations (financial or otherwise) to Active Dorset.

Security and Health and Safety

All users must comply with the instructions of any club officials in respect of any security or health and safety matter including fire drills, vacating the facility at the end of a booked session, and keeping exits free from obstruction.

There are two ambulance access points in case of an emergency: one immediately outside the community entrance and another outside the school entrance.

In an emergency please dial 999, the postcode for the facility is BH10 4EX. A key for the facility gates and barriers entering Slades Park is kept securely within the facility.

All users of the facility are required to have their own First Aid Provision as a condition of their booking.

It is the bookers responsibility to ensure that the fire and/or emergency procedure is adhered to. It is the responsibility of the lead booker to meet with Active Dorset in the facility premises to be inducted in all safety procedures for the facility (Evacuation Procedure for the 3G is issued to each lead facility user).

Alcohol

Alcoholic beverages must not be brought into or consumer in the facility. Individuals attending the facility must not be under the influence of alcohol.

Drugs

Individuals using the facility must not be in possession of, consumer or be under the influence of drugs.

Smoking

Smoking, including vaping is prohibited in or around the facility and in the enclosed 3G area.

Behaviour

Individuals must not cause offence and are always required to be considerate and respectful to others regardless of sex, race or ethnic origin, religion or belief, disability, age, or sexual orientation.

Noise

Individuals and teams must not create a level of noise that will act as a nuisance to local residents, School students or other park users. Please refer to the Slades Park Noise Management Plan 2019 for more details.

Illegal Behaviour

All individuals involved in facility lets are required to act in a way that is compliant with the law.

Storage and Equipment
